- ✓ Direct admission to a skilled nursing facility without having to meet the Medicare 3 midnight stay hospitalization rule
- ✓ Home visits when you do not qualify for Medicare's home health services
- ✓ Eligibility for participation in the chronic disease management reward program for those that meet the requirements
