## Where to go for care.

### Primary Care

Includes prevention and checkups, disease prevention, health maintenance, counseling, patient education, diagnosis, management and treatment of acute and chronic illnesses.

- Wellness exams • Disease prevention • Health maintenance • Diagnostic services, including x-rays & lab tests
- Management or treatment of acute and chronic conditions

### Walk-In Care / Urgent Care

Urgent medical conditions are ones that are not considered emergencies, require care within 24 hours and when you aren't able to see your Primary Care Provider.

- Accidents / falls • Cuts that don't involve much blood but might need stitches • Breathing difficulties • Eye irritation and redness • Diagnostic services, including X-rays and laboratory tests • Fever or flu • Minor broken bones and fractures in fingers or toes • Moderate back problems
- Severe sore throat or cough • Skin rashes and infections • Sprains and strains • Urinary tract infections • Vomiting or diarrhea

### Emergency Department

In general, an emergency condition is one that can permanently impair or endanger your life.

Some examples of conditions that need emergency medical care include:

- Compound fracture, which involves a bone protruding through the skin • Convulsions, seizures, or loss of consciousness • Deep knife wounds or gunshot wounds • Heart attack symptoms • Moderate to severe burns • Poisoning • Serious head, neck, or back injury • Severe abdominal pain • Severe chest pain or difficulty breathing
- Stroke symptoms • Suicidal or homicidal feeling
