POST-DISCHARGE HOME VISIT

BENEFIT ENHANCEMENT FOR NEXT GENERATION ACCOUNTABLE CARE ORGANIZATION (ACO) BENEFICIARIES FAQ

Hospital discharge can be stressful. As a Medicare beneficiary in the Next Generation Accountable Care Organization (ACO) Model, you may be eligible to receive home visits from a licensed or certified professional under the supervision of a provider. This service can help ease the transition from hospital to home care and help prevent readmission to the hospital.

AM I ELIGIBLE?

Medicare beneficiaries who receive care from a doctor participating in a Next Generation ACO, should have received a letter from the ACO regarding their participation. Eligible ACO beneficiaries must meet the following requirements to receive a post-discharge home visit:

- ✓ Must be aligned with the Next Generation ACO
- ✓ Have been discharged from an inpatient qualifying stay within past 30-days
- \checkmark Do not qualify for home health services
- \checkmark Can accept services in home / place of residence after discharge from a patient facility

Beneficiaries that experience one or more of the following criteria, may qualify for the benefit enhancement.

- Chronic health conditions
- ✓ Evidence of social risk factors
- Psychiatric, cognition, or substance abuse concerns
- ✓ New diagnosis and/or medication change with need for educational services
- ✓ Abrupt change in functional status
- Recovering from major surgery (or minor surgery with complications)
- History of frequent hospital admissions or re-admissions

Post-discharge home visit services may vary and can be utilized up to nine times in a 90-day period.

Services may include:

- ✓ Medication management/reconciliation
- ✓ Skin and wound care
- \checkmark Medication administration
- ✓ Nutrition care

- ✓ Respiratory therapy
- ✓ Physical or occupation therapy
- ✓ Caregiver education or training

How does this benefit differ from traditional home visits?

Unlike the traditional post-discharge home visit, this benefit allows your physician to provide general *supervision* to an outside, licensed, clinician that delivers services in a patient's home.

How much does this service cost?

The cost for this service (e.g., co-insurance), remains the same with or without the benefit enhancement. For more information, please visit the Medicare Part B coverage and costs at www.medicare.gov.

Can I choose my doctors and hospitals?

You have the ability to choose your doctors and hospitals, but this benefit only applies to beneficiaries who receive their care from a provider who partners with a Next Generation ACO. If you choose a provider who is not an ACO participant, normal Medicare rules apply.

How can I get started?
