Northwest Momentum Health Partners (NWMHP) Accountable Care Organization (ACO) works with your provider who has voluntarily aligned with the ACO, joining the network of local doctors, hospitals and other providers of healthcare to provide member benefits that go above and beyond the scope of Medicare services with an emphasis on quality outcomes and coordination of care.

NWMHP Care Navigators and Nurse Case Managers are available to coordinate non-emergency transportation to:

- Primary Care or Specialist appointments
- Pick up prescriptions or go to treatments ordered by a provider post discharge.
- Participate in other services related to health care goals such as Flu Vaccination or obtaining Durable Medical Equipment.
- Evaluation at an Urgent Care Clinic for Non-emergent changes in health status.

## This service is for members who:

- Are unable to access services through Medicaid or other community based resources.
- Do not have an active driver's license and family support is unable to provide transportation.
- Have an active driver's license however unable to drive due to acute or chronic health condition, such as recent eye surgery, ankle fracture, etc.
