As part of the ACO, you may be eligible to take part in additional programs, such as:

Telehealth: A way to visit a provider or certain specialist using technology, such as a computer or smart phone.

▶ Nursing Homes: If needed, Medicare allows our network of doctors to admit into certain nursing homes at any time - regardless of the Medicare required 3-day hospital stay.

► Home Visits after Hospital Stays: For beneficiaries that do not qualify for home health services, Medicare allows NWMHP to dispatch nurses and other skilled staff to homes - up to nine times (in a 90 day period) - following a hospital stay.

► Home Visits to Prevent Hospital Stays: For beneficiaries that do not qualify for home health services, Medicare allows NWMHP to send doctors or nurses to your home to help manage healthcare needs - up to 2 (two) times in 90 days.

► Reduced or Eliminated Out-of-Pocket Expenses: For beneficiaries who participate in the home visits, you may qualify for reduced or elimination of your costs for some Medicare Part B services.

Rewards for Participation in Programs: Eligible beneficiaries may qualify for gift cards of their choosing based on their participation in care management.
