We're writing to let you know that your doctor is part of **NW Momentum Health Partners** (**NWMHP**), a Medicare Accountable Care Organization (ACO). This means they've teamed up with other doctors, hospitals, and health care providers to make sure you get the best care.

All members of NWMHP work together to provide coordinated care for you to get well and stay well. You get patient-centered care focused on YOUR needs, and more coordination helps prevent medical errors and drug interactions. When all your providers can see the same test results, treatments and prescriptions, you may save time, money and frustration by avoiding repeated tests and appointments. Better communication can also help protect against Medicare fraud and waste.

Your regular Medicare benefits stay the same. You can always go to any doctor, hospital, or other provider that accepts Medicare. Since your doctor is connected with NWMHP, you may also have access to expanded benefits at no extra cost. These expanded benefits are listed below – ask your health care provider if you qualify.

Medicare protects the privacy of your health information. If you don't want Medicare to share information with your health care providers for care coordination, call 1-800-MEDICARE (1-800-633-4227). Medicare may still share general information to measure provider quality. For more information on how Medicare may use and give out your information, visit Medicare.gov and search for "privacy."

You may have access to additional free services. NWMHP offers multiple programs focused on helping you and your doctor manage your health. These programs include calls with a NWMHP nurse that can assist you to schedule a follow-up visit with your primary care provider, schedule rides to see your doctor or pharmacy, and even provide meal support to those in need. You can take advantage of these benefits by talking to your doctor and asking if you qualify.

NWMHP is located in Olympia, Washington and works with practitioners to help provide high-quality care. Our team of nurses and support staff are dedicated to offering services that increase the quality of the care you receive without impacting your Medicare benefits.

NWMHP services are voluntary and will never restrict where you receive care.

Here is a list of some of the available services:

<u>Direct Admission to a Skilled Nursing Facility (SNF)</u>: This service waives the requirement of a 3-day inpatient stay in a hospital before being admitted to a SNF.

Gift Card Reward Program: You may be eligible to join a voluntary program in which NWMHP can reward you with up to \$75 in gift cards for completing health care goals.

Home Health Services: You may be eligible to receive home health services even if you are not confined to your home.

<u>Support with Medical Expenses</u>: NWMHP may be able to help eliminate or reduce your out-of-pocket costs for certain services delivered by NWMHP participating practitioners.

<u>Community Resources</u>: NWMHP may be able to provide resources such as transportation, meal services, and other health care related items not covered by Medicare.
